A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FREEDOM TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGARDING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FREEDOM TOWNSHIP AND LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Freedom Township Board of Supervisors supports intergovernmental cooperation with neighboring Adams County municipalities in all areas of joint cooperation and services, and:

WHEREAS, the municipalities have the power and authority to contract for the purposes of borrowing, lending, exchanging and otherwise sharing vehicles, machinery and/or equipment (collectively, "Equipment"), with operators, with other municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Freedom Township and the Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township shall enter into an Intergovernmental Service Agreement and;

- Trade equal labor and equipment hours between the townships for Road Department work until withdrawn by either party,
- 2. Freedom Township will coordinate with Liberty Township on the dates, times, and services, provided in both Townships, and
- 3. Hours will be set and agreed upon prior to the start of each project.
- 4. Rates to be calculated using FEMA rates.
- 5. Notice of either party to withdraw must be given 30 days prior in writing.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Freedom Township does hereby adopt this resolution this 10th day of July 2024 at regular meeting which was duly convened in accordance with the law.
