At the regular meeting of the Freedom Township Board of Supervisors on July 11 1968 it was of Unanimous agreement that the feeling toward closing the covered bridge between Freedom and Cumberland Townships, over Marsh Creek at the Pupping Station, is the same now as it was in March 1965 when the Freedom Township Board met with the County Commissioners, Howard Waybright and Mr Martin, Notes from that meeting are as follows;

" It is the feeling that the County will maintain the bridge and will have the engineer inspect the bridge to determine if it is safe for auto traffic. The Townships will provide signs at the entrances limiting the traffic to automobiles. If it is determined unsafe for traffic and the County would not deem it profitable to repair it, the bridge would be closed to traffic, providing a court order could be obtained for closing"

The Board of Supervisors of Freedom Township is not in favor of closing the covered bridge to auto traffic.

ORDINANCE NO. 7
 An Ordinance Prohibiting Disorderly Conduct and Disturbances of the Peace Within Freedom Township, Prescribing the Penalties For Violation.
 Section 1: Disorderly conduct is hereby prohibited within Freedom Township. Any person who shall willfully make or cause to be made any loud, boisterous or unreasonably noisy or otherwise to the annoyance of the peaceable residents of the township, or near any street, road, alley, park, public grounds or other public or private property in Freedom Township, whereby the public peace is known or the traveling public is annoyed, is guilty of disorderly conduct.
 Section 2: Disturbance of the peace is hereby prohibited within Freedom Township. Any person who shall be guilty of any act, word or conduct causing or tending to cause a disturbance of the peace or good order of the township, or causing or tending to cause any danger, discomfort or annoyance to any of the inhabitants of Freedom Township or parts of the public streets, roads, alleys or sidewalks in the township by any of the following acts: loitering or soliciting or congregating upon any of the streets, roads, alleys or public grounds, so as to obstruct any part of the same or publicly using indecent or obscene language, in either of disturbing the peace.
 Section 3: Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace or District Judge be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Thirty Dollars and costs of prosecution and in default of payment such fine and costs, to be levied in the County Jail, or more than thirty (30) days, as directed and Ordained this day of _____ 1973.
