


RESOLUTION NO. 2019-05

This Resolution made this 14 day of August, 2019, by the Board of Supervisors of Freedom Township in a duly regular session, said Resolution stating as follows:


1. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Township's residents and citizens and benefit the health and welfare of the Township to provide a charging station on Township property for the purpose of charging electric vehicles.
2. The Board of Supervisors adopts this Resolution pursuant to its authority as set forth in the Second Class Township Code.
3. Providing this service to Township residents and citizens, and the general public, is good government and in the best interest of the Township.
4. The Township intends to provide said service by entering into an agreement with ChargePoint, Inc., a Delaware Corporation, and by the securing of grants and other contributions for the purpose of providing the service.
5. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the entering into said agreement and making this service available as provided in said agreement.
6. The Board of Supervisors also authorizes the purchase of the ChargePoint CT4000 level 2 commercial charging station, one (1) year ChargePoint Assure Warranty, three (3) year cloud plan, and other accessories in the amount of \$ 9757.00.


